

Privacy Policy

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to describe how Cloud Native Finland ry and its wholly-owned subsidiary Cloud Native Finland Events Ab ("we," "us," "organizer" or "our") collects, uses, maintains, and discloses information collected from participants and attendees ("you" or "attendee").

1. Information Collection

However, during our events, attendees may, completely voluntarily, allow a sponsor of the event to scan their event badge. By the attendee allowing the sponsor to scan their badge, the attendee authorizes the organizer to share the attendee's name, email address, job title and company information with the sponsor who scanned the badge.

We may, in addition, share aggregated, non-personally identifying information about the attendees with third parties. This includes, but is not limited to, producing public transparency reports.
